What Does Wisconsin's Private School Ombudsman Do?

- Monitors and enforces equitable participation of private school students, teachers and staff in federal education programs under the reauthorization of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, called The Every Student Succeeds Act or ESSA.
- Provides accurate information about what your students and staff are entitled to and how to access those services.
- Helps principals understand the best ways to utilize the services and funding available.
- Resolves any problems that may arise between your school and your local public school district
